(Offered in both English and Spanish)

What is CIBO?:

This is an online parenting course approved by the Court for divorcing or separating parents which teaches specific communication techniques to help minimize parental conflict and reduce the stress/harm on children.

1. **To Access the Program You Will Need:**

- a. Access to the internet.
- b. A personal e-mail address (if you do not have an e-mail address, see the program site for information on how to obtain a free e-mail address).
- c. If eligible, your **court order** stating fees are waived. (See #3 below.)

2. **To Register for the Course:**

- a. **Go To:** <http://online.divorce-education.com>.
- b. **Click on:** "*Purchase*" to complete your registration and pay the \$39.95 program fee. You will receive an e-mail confirmation of your registration along with your **Username** and **Password**.

3. **Registering for the Course using a Court Approved Fee Waiver (if eligible):**

- a. On your court order, which states fees are waived, take the following steps:
 - i. Write your **name, phone number and e-mail address** at the top of the order.
 - ii. Fax, E-mail or send (via regular mail) a copy of your court approved fee waiver:

- b. You will receive an e-mail confirmation of your registration along with your **Username** and **Password**. Please allow 48-72 business hours for the processing of fee waiver requests.

4. **Starting the Course:** Once you have received your **Username** and **Password**, return to the website: <http://online.divorce-education.com>

- a. **Click on:** "*Log on*" (upper right corner)
- b. Type in your **Username** and **Password**. Begin the course.

5. **What to do with your CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION:**

When you complete the course, and successfully pass, you will be issued a certificate of completion. Please **print one (1) copy for your records**. Next select the option below that "fits" your situation to ensure a **second copy** of the certificate is provided to the court:

Option 1

(You have a Case Number)

- a. **Make sure your case number appears on the certificate.** If it does not, type it in.
- b. **Email to the Court.** Once at the "Results Page" click on "*e-mail copies of the certificate*" and type in the e-mail address to the Cook County Court: **focus.certificates@cookcountyil.gov** (and your case number, if needed). A copy of your certificate will be sent directly to the Court. You can also e-mail a copy to yourself or attorney (if represented)

Option 2

(You Do Not have a Case Number)

- a. Print one (1) **extra** copy (you will now have 2).
- b. **Once a case is filed, write in your case number** and either **mail or hand deliver** one (1) copy of the certificate of completion to:
